

What is not M.I.G.

Examples of impairments which may not be M.I.G.'s

- Psychological
- Neurological (clinically relevant)
- TBI
- Fractures
- Joint dislocation
- Full tears of: muscle/tendon/ligaments

Removal from the M.I.G.

Pre-existing condition

- Health care professional (s) must provide compelling evidence that pre-existing condition will prevent the injured person from achieve MMR with in the M.I.G.

Removal from the M.I.G.

Pre-existing conditions:

- Degenerative disc disease
- Inflammatory disorders
- Neurological disorders
- Chronic fatigue syndrome
- Chronic pain syndrome
- Psychological condition

Removal from the M.I.G.

Pre-existing conditions:

- Heart/Lung conditions
- Diabetes
- Drug dependency
- Sleeping disorder
- Pre-accident abuse
- Smoking

After the M.I.G.

Conditions resulting from the accident

- CHRONIC PAIN SYNDROME!
- PSYCHOLOGICAL/PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
- MTBI
